



## REGISTRATION PACKAGE 2025

PLC Sports would like to welcome you to the Edinburgh Ice Hockey Cup. The tournament has been created to allow teams from all over the world to come to Edinburgh and compete in the Olympic tradition of good sportsmanship and great competition. The tournament games will be played on May 23<sup>rd</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>, and 25<sup>th</sup>, 2025 at the Murrayfield Ice rink in Edinburgh.

The tournament offers:

- 30+, 40+, 50+, 60+ and 70+ Divisions
- Each division can register up to 4 teams.
- Teams will play a 3-game round robin.
- Teams will be seated 1 through 4 in each pool.
- The 1<sup>st</sup> place team will play the 2<sup>nd</sup> place team for the Gold Medal and then 3<sup>rd</sup> place will play 4<sup>th</sup> place for the Bronze Medal.
- Gold, silver, and bronze medals will be awarded in each division.
- Each division will have awards for top scorer, best defencemen, best goalie and most sportsmanlike player. Game MVP awards will also be handed out.
- Players will receive a tournament t-shirt.
- There will be equipment storage space at the rinks.
- The tournament will have on-line schedule, standings, and stats.
- There will be 2 referees and a timekeeper for each game.
- A tournament banquet is being planned. Cost TBD.

The team tournament registration cost is 1,600.00 U.S.

The tournament offers 5 divisions for hobby players.

**30+ Division:** This division is for players 30 years and older. Each team will be permitted to have a total of 3 younger players. They must be 28 or 29 years of age. There will be 4 teams in this division.

**40+:** This division is for players 40 years and older. Each team will be permitted to have a total of 3 younger players. They must be 38 or 39 years of age. There will be 4 teams in this division.

**50+ This division** is for players 50 years and older. Each team will be permitted to have a total of 3 younger players. They must be 48 or 49 years of age. There will be 4 teams in this division.

**60+ This division** is for players 60 years and older. Each team will be permitted to have a total of 3 younger players. They must be 58 or 59 years of age. There will be 4 teams in this division.

**70+ This division** is for players 70 years and older. Each team will be permitted to have a total of 3 younger players. They must be 68 or 69 years of age. There will be 4 teams in this division.

This is a hobby tournament for the enjoyment of all hobby players. All team rosters will be checked to ensure all registrations are valid. Players may be required to show picture identification when they check in at the tournament desk.

Periods will be 2 23-minute straight time with the last 2 minutes of the game stop time. Teams will have a 3-minute warm up.

Each Pool will play a round robin. Teams will play 3 games and at the conclusion of the round robin (3 games) the teams will be seated 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup>.

The 1<sup>st</sup> Place team in each Pool will play for the championship trophy and the gold and silver medals. The 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams in each pool will play for the bronze medal. The 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams will play for placing and the 4<sup>th</sup> place teams will play for a final placing.

**Point System.** During the round robin, points will be awarded as follows: For every period a team wins, they will receive 1 point. If a period is tied, no points are awarded. The team that wins the game will receive 3 points. If a game is tied, each team will receive 1 point.

If a team wins both periods and wins the game, they will receive 5 points.

At the end of the round robin if 2 or more teams are tied, the following tie-breaking system will be used:

1. If two teams are tied the winner of the head-to-head game will be awarded the higher seed.
2. If three or more teams are tied, the team with the most wins will be awarded the higher seed.
3. The team with the most periods won points will be awarded the higher seed.
4. The team with the fewest goals allowed.
5. The team with the fewest penalty minutes.
6. Coin toss.

**TOURNAMENT REGISTRATION:** The tournament registration fee is **1,600.00 U.S.** The registration fee is due with your team registration. The tournament fee can be sent by wire transfer to the account listed above.

Your registration fee includes: the ice rental for all your games; 2 referees for each game; timekeepers and online standings; professional tournament organizing committee; Edinburgh Cup for each divisional champions, gold, silver, and bronze medals for the top 3 teams; MVP award for each team; top scorer, best defencemen and best goalie awards for each division, and a gift for all the players.

Payments in Euros will be made to the account of PLC Sports Travel.

#### Registration & Eligibility

1. Prior to the start of the tournament, participating teams must forward the team's tournament roster to the Tournament Committee by Mar. 1, 2025. Any changes to the roster after the schedule are drawn must be cleared with the Tournament Committee.
2. Teams must register with the Tournament Committee prior to playing their first tournament game at the hotel.
3. All players participating must be designated tournament age or turn the designated age by the end of the same calendar year. Players may be asked to show picture identification when they register.
4. A team who is found to have used an ineligible player in a tournament game(s) shall have the game(s) defaulted. The Tournament Committee may take further action against the offending team depending on the severity of the infraction.

**INSURANCE: All PLAYERS PARTICIPATING IN THE EDINBURGH ICE HOCKEY CUP MUST HAVE THEIR OWN MEDICAL HEALTH INSURANCE THAT COVERS THEM WHILE IN EDINBURGH AT THE TOURNAMENT. PLC SPORTS MANAGEMENT INC. DOES NOT PROVIDE HEALTH INSURANCE FOR ANY PLAYERS AT THE TOURNAMENT.**
