

Letter to members 2021 – SIF's centenary year!

Information on membership and activity fees for 2021 will be sent out in week 7 and must be paid by 28 February 2021. The Bankgiro number and OCR number on the invoice **must** be quoted when making payment so that members are automatically marked off in the membership system as having paid. Please pay your fees on time so that we don't send you reminders.

All members with email addresses registered in the membership register at laget.se will receive their invoices electronically by email. Invoices will be sent by post otherwise.

Billogram

Membership and activity fees will be invoiced by Billogram. This company works in partnership with laget.se, which is where Skene IF keeps its membership register. This service streamlines the work of both Skene IF and its managers, who can now use an app on their phones to easily check who's paid their team fees.

Billogram charges SEK 10 per invoice by email and SEK 20 per invoice by post for its invoicing service. If you received your invoice by post last year but have an active email address, please send your email address by email to kansliet@skeneif.com

All Skene IF players must have paid both their membership fee and their activity fee to be allowed to train and play in matches or cup ties.

Sports insurance

Get free access to a doctor who specialises in sporting injuries.

Players are insured by Folksam via the club after paying their membership and activity fees in full. This insurance cover provides good basic protection in case players are injured during training, matches or cup ties.

This insurance policy also includes the "Advice and care for sporting injuries" service ("*Råd och Vård för idrottsskador*"). This service is free of charge to insured players. You can phone this service in order to talk to a physiotherapist on how to prevent, treat and report sporting injuries. The physiotherapist decides whether the sporting injury needs to be treated, and if so books a free appointment for the player with a physiotherapist or doctor specialising in sporting injuries. Phone 020 44 11 11 between 8am and 5pm on weekdays.

Important – contact the office first for a reference number – you have to state this when you phone Folksam. The office will look at the membership register and check that the player is a member when doing this.

Membership fees for 2021

Individual: SEK 300

Family: SEK 600 (*all family members are included*).

Activity fees for 2021

SEK 350: PF-14, F-12/13, P-12/13.

SEK 450: P-11, P-10, F-10/-11.

SEK 550: P-09, F-09

SEK 650: P-08, P-06/-07, U19

Note – please pay every invoice individually. If the family has opted for Family membership, one invoice will be sent to the guardian for the membership for the whole family. Activity fees are personal and linked with the player themselves, so they'll be invoiced for these. Every invoice has a unique OCR number that must be quoted when making payment, so every invoice must be paid individually.

Benefit the club by choosing Family membership

Contributions to the association are frequently based on the number of members. If you have two club members in your family, we really do recommend that you choose Family membership. This means everybody in the family will be members at the same price, and you'll benefit the club as our number of members will increase. Of course, we also urge all other families to choose this option even if only one person in your family is a member.

Sales activity, spring 2021

The association was forced to cancel events in 2020 on account of the pandemic, thereby taking away vital sources of income. But the association wasn't idle – we immediately started looking at other ways of bringing in money. Bingolotto sales became absolutely crucial to the club's finances, and that situation continues today. Last spring, Skene IF was selected by Folkspel to be 1 of 12 clubs in Västra Götaland given the opportunity to sell lottery tickets with commission rates of no less than 50% for the club. Folkspel gave us a sales target for both Bingolotto tickets and Sverigelotto tickets, and we managed to reach this target with the help of all our teams.
